Corzo Tequila Silver

Notes:

An exceptionally elegant and flavorful tequila with notes of citrus and vanilla, Corzo silver is best enjoyed as a sipping tequila or when prepared with the highest quality of mixers. The Corzo bottle was created by designer Fabien Baron, a designer for fashion, fragrance and entertainment.

Reviews:

Santé (06/01/2006) - Bold and peppery with excellent weight and structure and aromas and flavors of tangerine peel and cucumber; pleasing bite in the finish.

Wine Enthusiast(10/01/2006) - HIGHLY RECOMMENDED -- A fresh and seductive fragrance that includes scents of cucumber, agave pulp, fennel, pine, coriander and mint. The palate entry is smooth and correctly agave juice-sweet; at midpalate the flavors meld into a semisweet and lusciously prickly taste thrust. Finishes on a heated note as the spirit races ahead of the agave. -- SUPERB (90-95)



Martini & Rossi Asti

Notes:

This delightful, sparkling wine is sweet, yet refreshing. Excellent with desserts, or try it alone after a meal. Like other Spumante, this wine is made in a tank but chilled down to stop fermentation once the alcohol reaches about 9%. The nose is quite aromatic; the taste is sweet, full, and round on the palate with a fruity finish.
