RON ZACAPA CENTENARIO RUM 23 YEAR



Notes:: Dark mahogany, dense with marvelous complexities of aroma and flavor; thick legs that fall short. Hand wrapped in royal palm leaves and produced from a blend of vintage rums with up to 23 years of barrel age, Ron Zacapa Centenario represents the pride of Guatemalan rums, the pride of closely guarded recipes known only to skilled master blenders, and the pride of a government that strictly mandates the aging process.

Review :

Santé(01/01/2009) - Full and heavy on the palate with aromas and flavors of brown sugar, caramel, sandalwood, and some smoke. Dark amber in color with a rustic complexity, yet smooth and balanced.

LA CREMA

La Crema was founded in 1979 and quickly established itself as a pioneer for intensely flavored Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

LA CREMA CHARDONNAY SONOMA COAST



Notes:: This Chardonnay from cool, coastal regions provides plenty of refreshing acidity to pair with the flavors of rich, ripe grapes. The fruit came from all along the Sonoma County coast, starting with the renowned Carneros, then up to the Russian River Valley, and on to the Mendocino county boundary.

LA CREMA PINOT NOIR SONOMA COAST

Notes:: Aromas of ripe cherry, cocoa, anise and rich baking spices. Plush flavors of cherry, plum and pomegranate meld with hints of delicate tea leaf. Structured, balanced acidity and elegant, firm tannins round out the mouth.
