MOUNT GAY RUM EXTRA OLD

Notes: *Burnt sugar and vanilla are now in the forefront, with tropical fruit and banana on the nose. Quite sweet, and it goes down easy sans water despite being 86 proof.*



Review: *Santé(01/01/2009) - Medium amber-orange in color; rich, full bodied, and very smooth with concentrated aromas and flavors. Harmonious from start to smoky finish.*

CONUNDRUM 2009

Notes: *The spicy muscat canelli, fruity and herbaceous sauvignon blanc, viscous chardonnay and flavor-broadening sémillon were each delicately identifiable in the blend, resulting in a uniquely flavored wine that showcased the special attributes inherent in each grape used, and treating the palate to wonderful tastes and textures obtained from whole cluster pressing, barrel fermentation and partial malolactic fermentation.*
